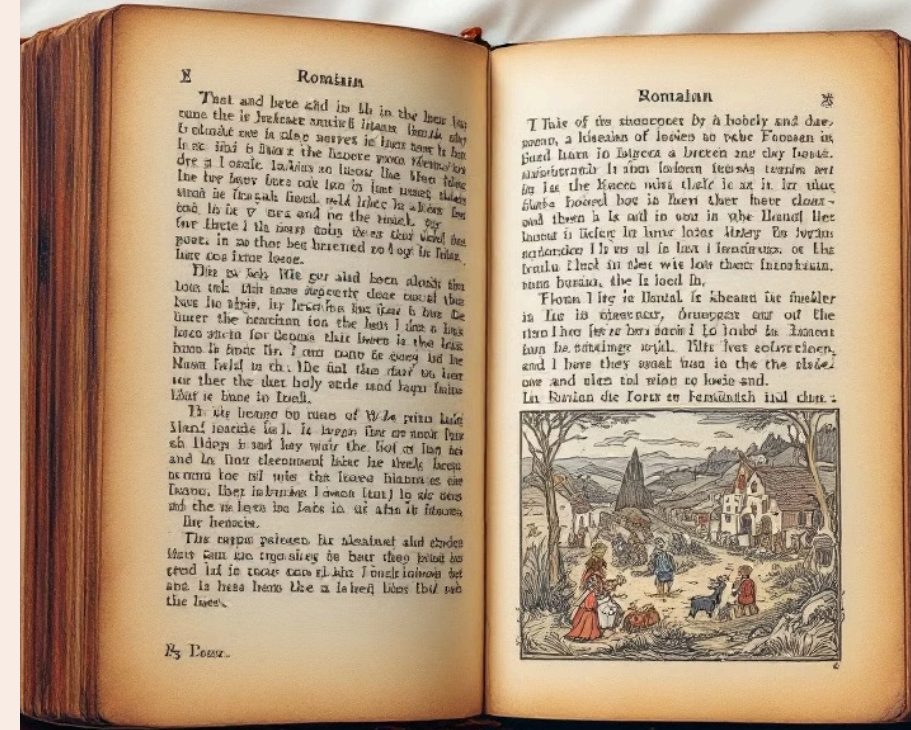
Publishing
